- Position the WWCS to serve future generations.



Beth Call, Elementary School Teacher at Assumption:

"I was in the first class to attend all four years at DeSales, graduating in 1963. The Sisters of Providence and the priests were outstanding and inspiring teachers who made a huge impact on my life. I attended Seattle University for one year and graduated from the University of Washington in 1967 with a B.A. in English. I got my Washington State teaching certificate through Whitman College, later upgrading it with a fifth year at Eastern Washington University in 1982.

My mother taught speech, math, and Latin at DeSales. My children, Christopher and Madeleine, graduated from Assumption and DeSales. I began teaching at Assumption in 1980; most of my career was spent teaching fourth grade. I felt grateful to the priests and sisters who had provided me with a solid academic background, and more importantly, with strong spiritual values. I always wanted to pass on these gifts to future generations. I have especially enjoyed teaching the children of former students. I cannot imagine a more worthwhile career, and I look back at my thirty-two years of teaching at Assumption with gratitude.

Cliff Olds, Spanish Teacher at Assumption and DeSales:

"In 1968 I graduated from Montana State with a B. S. in Education, majoring in German and minoring in Spanish. In 1993 I received my M.Ed. in Spanish from Western Washington University. In 1999, I spent a year teaching Spanish and English in Hamburg, Germany as a Fulbright Exchange teacher.

Some of my most pleasing moments at the WWCS were watching the expansion of the Spanish department. In 2011, my fourth year students took the AP Spanish test. One of them received a 5 and the majority received a 4. The students, faculty, and parents were always so very supportive and welcoming from my very first day at DeSales. Students and parents simply don't realize how much their actions and comments can inspire a teacher to work harder to make the classroom better. That was the case with me. The more good feedback I received, the harder I tried to reach a better level. In addition it has brought me great satisfaction in seeing others become inspired to major or minor in Spanish at the university level. And what could be better than to see one of my former students take over for me in my retirement."

We begin our high school evaluation in the eighth grade, prior to a student's arrival at DeSales. Through the administration of the EXPLORE test and one on one counseling sessions with parents and student, we start to map out a student's high school course work for the coming years.

Each subsequent grade brings a new evaluation and adjustment to a student's schedule. All this work culminates in the taking of the ACT and SAT and preparation for college applications and a successful graduation.

Along the way we provide everything from access to online tools and real-time assessments, to an after school study table staffed by faculty and tutors from Whitman College, to supplemental English courses, and a growing catalog of new courses.

Ultimately, we survey the field before us and work to implement the most effective methods for success. These fields have continually produced tremendous yields, and we seek to develop practices that will not only continue this tradition but reap even greater harvests.



DeSales Athletics 2011-2012

We had much to be thankful for in the win-loss column for the 2011-2012 sports season, but more importantly, we are pleased once again that every athletic team at DeSales qualified for the WIAA Academic Awards.

DeSales is a small school and with that we rely on all our students playing and participating not only on one team but sometimes two or three. In the beginning these students may not have the most natural talent for the sport they are playing, but in order to insure we can form a team they are willing to try their best and give their all. The act of participation makes a difference in all their lives and the results many times surpass the original goal of just being part of a team.

- Every athletic team at DeSales qualified for the WIAA Academic Awards.
- DeSales junior, Reilly Roach, was chosen as one of twelve state-wide representatives to the WIAA LEAP committee. This committee is composed of students and is designed to get student input on issues within the WIAA.
- Irish Football team made it to the top 16 in the state once again.
- Lady Irish Volleyball made it to the state tournament in Yakima, which put them in the top 16 in the state as well.
- Irish Football Team won the WIAA 2B Academic State Championship and received their award at the Tacoma Dome.
- Lady Irish Basketball won the D. A. Davidson Christmas Classic tournament, took number 1 in the league, and represented the Irish very well at the District 9 tournament.

A Year in Sports

- Irish Boys' Baseball won their fourteenth state title.
- Lady Irish Softball made it to the state tournament in Yakima once again, competing very well for an extremely young team.
- Irish Track performed as follows at the state track tournament: Nick Wales took first place in the 300 meter hurdles and Anthony Brown took fourth in the discus.
- Lady Irish Track showed success at the state tournament when Alison Wujek took second in the high jump, fifth in the long jump, and sixth in the 100 meter hurdles. Alison also set a new Irish school record in the high jump.
- Irish Boys' Golf team won the first state championship in the sport for DeSales. Junior Ryan Baumgart won his second individual state championship in a row, Bryce Scott took eighth place, and Jerod Konen took thirteenth place.
- Irish Girls' Golf had eighth grader Emily Baumgart win her first individual state championship.

Dear Alumni, Parents, Friends, Faculty, Staff and Supporters of the Walla Walla Catholic Schools:

Over the past 148 years, the Walla Walla Catholic Schools have offered an exceptional education that provided the opportunity of a quality future for our students. From our Catholic Schools beginning in 1864, with the establishment of Saint Vincent Academy, and con-

tinuing through today at Assumption Early Learning Center, Elementary and Middle School and DeSales High School, the successful careers of so many students began here. In case after case, our Alumni have become society's leaders throughout the Pacific Northwest and beyond. The Walla Walla Catholic Schools is a place "Where Every Student is Needed and Every Student is Important". We believe that our schools' philosophy of educating the whole person, academically, spiritually, physically and socially has been the recipe for the extraordinary success of so many of our students.

Since tuition covers only 64% of the cost of each of our student's education, we must ask everyone to give generously to the annual fund.

Building upkeep and improvements, including the recently completed renovation of the DeSales gym, replacing

computer technology, new text books, updating other academic and mechanical equipment and a great deal of financial aid is not included in the school's budget. Consequently, we must also seek assistance to underwrite the cost of capital projects from time-to-time.

Traditionally, capital fund drives were conducted every five years; however, nine years had passed by the time "Momentum-Moving Catholic Education Forward", our current five year capital campaign, began in September, 2010. The active face-to face solicitation is now concluding. Over \$2.0 million, thus far has been contributed to our Catholic Schools and the Endowment Association, allowing the schools to continue to offer a superior education. The outpouring by so many supporters has been heartening. The generosity of donors in such an unpredictable economy and in such a short time has been nothing short of miraculous. On behalf of today's students, faculty, staff, school board members and the volunteer members of the "Momentum" Campaign Committee, we ask each and every contributor to accept our heartfelt thanks for giving back to one of God's important ministries some of what He has given you.

Thank you to all for your prayers on behalf of the continued success of our Catholic Schools and the "Momentum" campaign.






